- Motifs: organic, especially floral and other plant-inspired
- Part of the Arts and crafts movement.

Painting and graphic arts

- **Two-dimensional** : appeared in popular forms such as advertisements, posters, labels, magazines, etc.
- Some line and curve patterns became graphic patterns that were later found in works of artists from all parts of the world.
